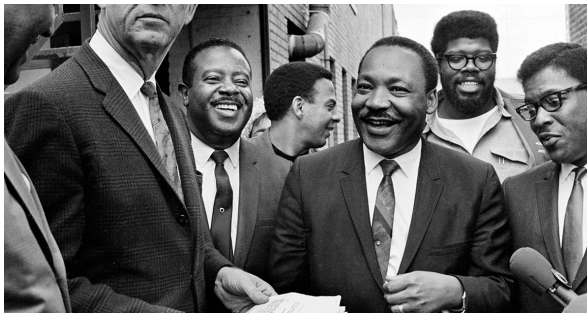


ADULT FORUM

THIS FORUM WILL EXPLORE AN OFTEN-NEGLECTED ASPECT OF MARTIN LUTHER KING'S LIFE AND THOUGHT: THAT OF PASTOR. DR. KING, WHILE OFFERING MODELS OF PROPHETIC MINISTRY AND RESISTANCE TO OPPRESSION, ADDRESSED THE DEEPER ASPECTS OF "SOUL-WORK" FOR PERSONS, COMMUNITIES AND THE WIDER PUBLIC SQUARE; KING SOUGHT TO OVERCOME THE THE FALSE DICHOTOMY BETWEEN PROPHET AND PASTOR BY PLACING THE INDIVIDUAL ALWAYS WITH THE CONTEXT OF SOCIAL FORCES AND OPPRESSION; YET, HE ALSO ADDRESSED THE "INNER LIFE" OF BOTH PERSONS AND COMMUNITIES, AND PROVIDED RICH AND PROVOCATIVE VISION FOR EMOTIONAL AND CLINICAL DYNAMICS FOR INDIVIDUAL AND SOCIAL TRANSFORMATION. DR. KING WAS TRULY A NATIONAL PASTORAL GUIDE AND SPIRITUAL DIRECTOR OF THE HIGHEST ORDER. HE OFFERS PRACTICAL WISDOM IN ADDRESSING THE SOUL NEEDS OF OUR DIVIDED AND POLARIZED NATION TODAY.
